

This is the earliest evidence we have of any deliberate gathering of the family. It is a photo taken about 1928 just outside the gate in front of Grandpa Jep's house. As best we can tell at present this was the last house to stand on this site and the one in which he died. There was at least one earlier home and a photo of it is, or soon will be, elsewhere on this site.

These are all siblings or spouses of siblings. They are identified by name as well as the genealogy ID#. They are all recorded on the family group record of their father, John Seaborn Alford, which is linked from Jephtha's main page.

The families of each of Grandpa Jep's siblings are listed in family group records which are linked from the Childrens, etc. item on the main page.
