 to and in two Negroes now in the possession  
 of Isaac and Mary alford devised to us at  
 the death of the said Mary alford by the  
 names of Anne and Stephy to the said  
 the alford and to his heirs and assigns  
 for ever and we the said Randolph and  
 Susan Reading with our heirs and assigns  
 For the consideration above named warrant  
 and defend our Interest to and in the said  
 Negroes to the said the alford and assigns  
 against the claims of all manner of persons  
 what so ever in whomever where of we have  
 to these presents set our hands this the 4<sup>th</sup>  
 day Nov. 1834 -
