Know all men by these presents, that we Randolph Redding and Susan Redding Both of the County of Wake and State of North Carolina for and In consideration of the Sum of Forty five dollars to us in hand paid by Eli Alford of the County of Wake and State of North Carolina Relinquish our right title and Interest to and in two negroes now in the pofsession [sic] of Isaac and Mary Alford devised to us at the death of the Said Mary Alford by the names of Annes and Stepny to the Said Eli Alford and to his heirs and afsigns [sic] for ever and we the Said Randolph and Susan Redding with our heirs and afsigns [sic] For the consideration above named warrent and defend our Interest to and in the Said negroes to the Said Eli Alford and afsigns [sic] against the Claims of all manner of persons what So ever in witness where of we have to these presents Set our hands & Seals the 4th day Nov 1834.
