be sold on a credit of six months - and the Court  
doth appoint Joseph Furber a Commissioner to make  
said sale and he is to give thirty days  
notice by public advertisement of the time & place  
place of sale. said sale to be made in the town of  
Rohovilla, and he is to take bond with good  
sureties of the purchasers, and report his  
proceedings in the premises to the next Court.
