(12) Wake County 3 May session A.D. 1846.

To the Sheriff the Letter of the Court of Pleas & Quarter Sessions  
for said County.

The Petition of Willie Clifton in right of his wife - and  
of the said Willie Clifton (as the Benjamin & a son of Eli Alford  
Randall Riddings wife, Martin High & wife Dolly & Bailey Cliftons  
Gilbert Alford, John Mitchell, <sup>Administrator</sup> in right of his wife - Willie  
Buttsworth and of Joseph Finch the administrator  
of Bailey Alford deceased.

3 Humbly Complaining your  
Petitioners were unto your Honors that many years ago  
Joseph Alford departed this life having duly made his last  
will and testament, which has been proven and recorded a copy  
of which is herewith filed as a part of this petition. And that  
in said will among other things he binded and legated  
is follows to wif "I leave to my daughter Mary Alford  
the negroes the name of Dufour as also my old mill land  
on Seaford Creek adjoining Robert Buttsworth during her  
natural life & after her death my will & desire is that her  
son Bailey Alford should have it to him & his heirs forever - And  
also my will and desire is that said negro and all he wherein  
to be equally divided among my said daughters children after  
her death to them & their heirs forever - And your Petitioners sheweth  
the aforesaid Mary Alford departed this life sometime soon hence  
during the present year - that said Dufour is also dead, but  
the said negro had the following children a son (to wit) Stephen  
Armie and Letham - And that said Mary Alford had the  
following children to wit - wife of Willie Clifton, Cole Alford  
wife of Randall Riddings, Gilbert Alford, Wmmy

of John Melchior Delly wife of Martin High - Melchior Butler  
daughter ~~wife of Melchior High~~ - wife of Delly Clefton  
and Baby Ilford - That the said Baby Ilford has died  
several years since and your Petitioner Joseph Fowler is  
his administrator And your Petitioner Melchior Butler  
shows that he is the purchaser & owner of the right title  
in trust of the following Distributors & children in said slaves  
(to wit) of the slaves of Eli Alford, Randal Riddings & wife  
Martin High wife & Baby Clefton wife and her two Betes of  
slaves and - that from them ready to exhibit are produced  
wherein he shall be required so to do and pray that their  
slaves and interest in said slaves may be delivered to him  
as aforesaid or paid to him And your Petitioner  
being advised that they are tenants in common of said  
slaves and to have said slaves displaced and their  
share in said slaves on the proceeds of the sales of  
them appraised & account for their use & benefit And they  
further that there being only three <sup>three</sup> right slaves of different  
ages & values and many <sup>legit</sup> legacies in distributors that a  
division of said slaves cannot be made without injury  
to some of the parties interested and pray your  
worships to direct a sale of said slaves and to appoint  
the Clerk or some other fit person a Commissioner to  
make a sale of them on a credit of not less than six  
months after giving thirty days notice by publick ad  
vertisement in three or more publick places of the same place  
and towns of sale - and that the person so appointed  
take back and good rentes of the purchases for  
the purchase money and report all his proceedings

in the premises in this case to the most benefit and that your  
benevolence be given to each of the captives & Palenmers in tended  
him or her vulnerable than is usually after the proceeds of such  
sales - And that said sale of slaves be made according  
to the act of assembly in such cases provided. And  
your Palenmers pray for each other & further relief as
