1850 OH Fairfield Co. He was age 63, born VA farmer with \$2,000 property Wife Mary was 64 born in Ireland. Two children, John 23 and Henry 20 were both born in Ohio.

Fielding entered the War of 1812 as a private in Capt. Matthew Rogers' Co. of Pa. Militia. In August of 1813 he responded to a call from O. H. Perry, Commodore of the Fleet on Lake Erie. He served on Perry's ship, the LAWRENCE. Fielding's first son, ROBERT PERRY ALFORD was named for Commodore Perry.

"I just had the opportunity to spend one day in Ohio and I came back with the tombstone inscription for my FIELDING ALFORD. (Cemetery records for the old graves were lost long ago, according to those in charge.) FIELDING ALFORD d. Feb. 19, 1854 66 yrs. 10 mos. 27 days. According to my calculations that would put his date of birth on March 23, 1787..." (Kay Ann Feiden 2/10/1985)
