From Alford Family Notes: 3. Charles Richard Alford, eldest son of the above Charles and Elizabeth Alford, was born at St. Audries Rectory, 13 Aug. 1816. At the age of eight he was sent to London, and placed under the care of John Coles Symes, who was first-cousin to both his father and his mother. Having been entered at St. Paul's School, he passed in due time, with "the Canden"-a valuable scholarship-to Trinity College, Cambridge, taking his B.A. in 1839, M.A. in 1842, and D.D. in 1867. Ordained by the Bishop of Lincoln to the curacy of Finningley, he became successively Incumbent of St. Matthew's, Rugby, Vicar of Christ Church, Doncaster, and then for ten years Principal of the Metropolitan Training College at Highbury. On 2 February 1867, he consecrated, in Canterbury Cathedral, Bishop of Victoria, Hong Kong, an appointment of the Foreign Office. Retiring in 1872, he afterwards administered for a time the Diocese of Huron, Canada, settling in his later years at Kensington, and finally at Brighton.

"Bishop Alford in the advanced years of his retirement was a very regular member of the C.M.S Committee, where he was noted for his geniality, and for the rather unsual combination of decided Protesantism with a vigilant guardianship of the rightful position of a Bishop." (History of C.M.S.,

Charles Richard Alford married first, at St. Margaret Pattens, London, 21 July 1841, Sarah Jacosha, daughter of John Fleet, of Fenchurch Street. She died 22 October 1876, and is interredin the Bidstone Cemetery, Cheshire, where is the following inscription:

"Sarah Jacosha Alford, the beloved wife of The Right Reverend Bishop Alford, D.D., Sometime Bishop of Victoria. She fell asleep in Jesus on 22nd of October 1876; in the 60th year of her age."

Bishop Alford married, secondly, September 26, 1877, Emma, daughter of Edward Sheardown, solicitor, formerly of Doncaster, who survives him.

Bishop Alford died at Tunbridge Wells, June 13, 1898, in his 82nd year, and was buried in the cemetery there, under a recumbent cross of polished red granite, on which is the following inscription:

"Charles Richard Alford, D.D., Sometime Lord Bishop of Victoria, Born at St. Audries Rectory, Somersetshire, August 13, 1816, Died at Tunbridge Wells, June 13, 1898. Aged 81 years, 'Waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ'."

His will in abstract was as follows:

"Charles Richard Alford, Doctor of Divinity, sometime Bishop of Victoria, dated 15 April 1896. Proved 1898. My wife Emma Alford sole Executrix. My debenture stock in the Green Western Railway To my son Charles John Alford money in the hands of Messrs. Thompson, of 38, Mincing Lane, in the city of London my son the Rev. Josiah George Alford my son Robert Gervase Alford my son Edward Fleet Alford my sister Mrs. Frances Okell my niece Constance Annie Fleet the silver plate presented to me and engraven with a mitre to Josiah George Alford and Edward Fleet Alford, my two sons who have children to inherit it. My wife shall have during her lifetime all the remainder of my silver plate Teapot with inscription Silver soup ladle and twelve table spoons to my son Robert. To my son Edward my sapphire ring, being a memorial ring of Daniel Wilson, Bishop of Calcutta, formerly the property of my cousin John Coles Symes, and given by him to his cousin, the Rev. Richard Symes, who gave it to me, his nephew. My gold watch, given to me by Miss Anne Mary Fleet, and engraven with a mitre and initials C.R.V, to my grand-daughter Marion Grace Alford. The gold watch chain formerly worn by my father, the Rev. Charles Alford, with four seals attached, to my son Robert. The portrait of his great-great-grandfather John Coles, Vicar of Bridgwater, to my son Josiah. My books and manuscripts Residue to my wife." (From Original Will)

Bishop Alford died head of his family; and through his mother Elizabeth Symes, and through his grandmother Betty Sydenham-there being no male heir in either case-was the direct lineal representative of the Bridgwater branch of the family Symes, and of the Westowe branch of the ancient family of Sydenham. All three families were of the co. of Somerset, in which county Bishop Alford was a landowner, holding the farms of Budleigh and Powell's, near Taunton, at the time of his death, which

passed by entail to his son Josiah George Alford. The north transept window in Cleeve Church is filled with stained glass as a memorial in his native county, while a canopied episcopal throne in the Cathedral at Hong Kong was erected as a memorial in his Colonial Diocese.

From Alford Family Notes: "7. Charles John Alford, eldest son, was born at Rugby, 2 August 1843. He was educated at the Doncaster Grammar School, and later at a London School of Science, gaining some early mining experience in Wales. After some years in the Peninsular and Oriental service he became a mining Inspector and Engineer, in which profession he has gained considerable repute, being spoken of as "one of the best-known of our mining-engineers". He is the author of several technical works, amongst others: Engineering Notes on Cyprus 1880; Geological Features of the Transvaal, 1891; Ancient and Prospective Gold Mining in Egypt, 1900. He is a great traveller, a Fellow of the Geological Society, and a member of the Society of Engineers.

"Mr. C.J. Alford married, in 1871, Mary Helena, daughter of the Rev. William MacDermott, formerly of Montrose, N. B., and afterwards Chaplain of the Westminster Hospital. They have no family."

From Alford Family Notes: "9. Robert Gervase Alford, third son of the Bishop, was born at Doncaster 25 July 1848. He was a scholar of King's College, London, and trained as a civil engineer under Mr. Henry Carr-then engaged in rebuilding Blackfriars Bridge. Going out to China with his father in 1867, he entered the Colonial Service as Assistant-Engineer at Hongkong; and later, after ten years of private practice in the East, was employed at Ports mouth for the Torpedo Range works, and at Dover for the Harbour of Refuge Survey. In 1886 he was appointed Assistant-Surveyor of Works to the Prison Department in Scotland, living in Edinburgh. In 1902 he was moved to London, to a post under the Prison Commission at the Home Office, and lives at Hampstead. He became F.R.G.S. in 1878, M. Inst. C.E. in 1884, and F.R.S.E. in 1894.

"Mr. R.G. Alford married, 6 Nov. 1979, at Chirst Church, Claughton, Cheshire, Marion, eldest daughter of James Ashburner of Fernleigh, Oxton. They have no children."

From Alford Family Notes: (some to later be integrated into the genealogy) 4. Thomas Alford, second son of Charles Alford and Elizabeth his wife, was born in St. Audries Rectory, 16 Sept. 1817, baptized privately Oct. 1st,and received into church May 10th in the following year. With his elder brother he was taught in childhood by a governess at home, and, following his brother to London in due time, lived in 31, Fenchurch Street, with John Coles Symes and his sister Mary Symes, and attended the "Merchant Tailors'", a celebrated London Public School.

An incident of this London life is worthy of record. The two boys, pining for their country freedom, surreptitiously and laboriously carried stores of earth up the many stairs to of the tall city house, and gaining access through a window to a small lead flat, made there a garden on the roof. Their terribly dangerous journeys to and fro were at length observed by an opposite neighbour, a message was sent across the street, and a stern prohibition brought the boys' rus in urbe, with its perilous joy, to an end.

His school days over, Thomas Alford bade farewell to England, never to return. Sailing for Australia, he made his way to Queensland, and settled at length at Toowoomba, on the Darling Downs. There he prospered, and marrying (7 Aug. 1839) Elizabeth, eldest daughter of George Boulton of West Maitland, brought up a large family, who are spreading and prospering in Queensland and New South Wales. Thomas Alford died at Toowoomba when only forty-seven years of age, 9th Jan. 1864, his widow surviving him forty-one years, and passing away at Toowoomba 12th Oct. 1905.

He, too, went out with his father to China in 1867, and entered the service of Jardine, Matheson and Co., at Hongkong, becoming later a partner and representative of the firm at Shanghai, where he was also a Justice of the Peace. He retired in 1900, and lived in Kensington. In 1901 Lord Lansdowne, Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, asked for his assistnce at the Foreign Office and Board of Trade with reference to a new commercial treaty with China. In August that year the London "Times" stated:"

"We are informed by the Foreign Office that Sir Alfred Bateman and Mr. E.F. Alford, late Chairman of the Shanghai Chamber of Commerce, are engaged in revising the duties of the Tariff for the forthcoming negotiations with the Chinese Government."

"The Treaty was signed in the autumn of 1902, and the Birthday Honour List, Nov.9, stated:

"His Majesty has been pleased to confer the honour of Knighthood upon E.F. Alford, Esquire." "The notification was published that:

"Mr. Alford has received his knighthood on the recommendation of the Foreign Office, for important services in connection with the China Tariff."

"The King's Speech on the prorogation of Parliament, 18 December 1902, contained the following paragraph:

"I have concluded with his Imperial Majesty the Emperor of China a commercial treaty, which promises to secure not only for this country, but for the commerce of the world, valuable facilities and advantages."
