There is a Cincinatus town and township. The former is on the Otselic River. At the time of Zina's birth it would have been in Onondaga County - Cortland not being formed until 1808.

Published history of Hancock County, OH says he died in 1882.

During their lifetime Zina and Aurilla lived in Steuben Co., NY (20 years) New Jersey, Massachusetts and Hancock County, Ohio. Moved to Ohio in 1848 and purchased 65 acres of land.
