AAFA Notes:

1. Elroy's Alford lineage: Elroy Raymond 1934 OK¹, Elwood Seymour 1911 OK², Thomas Wildcat 1860 OK³, George Wildcat 1825 ??⁴.
2. Elroy was a member of the Absent Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma. His paternal great-grandfather, George Wildcat, added the Alford name after an Alford officer save his life. (We haven't identified the Alford officer.)
3. Elroy was an active and enthusiastic AAFA member. He made and donated bird houses and wooden angels as raffle and door prizes for many AAFA annual meetings. He also contributed extensive information on his Native American ancestor, Thomas Wildcat Alford.
