1. **Jacob Egloff Alford** b. Apr 13 1913, McComb, Pike Co., MS, m. Sep 24 1938, in Woodville, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, **Margaret Elizabeth Treppendahl**, b. Oct 1 1916, Woodville, Wilkinson County, Mississippi. Jacob died Dec 19 2002, Covington, St. Tammany Parish, LA. He was the first baby born in the "new" McComb City Hospital and was nicknamed "Hospital Jake" for many years. He is a founding member of the Alford American Family Association, #016. Jan 20 1843, Georgetown, Copiah County, Mississippi, d. Mar 30 1869, Copiah Co., MS, buried: Catchings Cem., Copiah County, MS, m. (2) Sep 29 1870, in Copiah Co., MS, 5. Julia Catchings Steele, b. Jan 6 1850, Copiah Co., MS, d. Apr 12 1916, Pike Co., MS, buried: Alford Cemetery, Copiah County, MS. James died Jul 16 1894, Copiah Co., MS, buried: Alford Cemetery, Copiah County, MS. He died of a stroke. In the Civil War he was a hospital steward. He was enumerated in the censuses of Copiah Co, MS 1850 10, 1860 21, 1870 30 and 1880 40. He is mentioned in Harllee's KINFOLKS, page 1318 CA20ac11.

8. **Julius Caesar Alford** b. Dec 15 1808, Alfordsville, Robeson County, NC, m. Jan 22 1835, in Copiah Co., MS, **9. Mary Jane "Jency" Cammack**, b. Jan 22 1815, Sumner County, Tennessee, d. Oct 7 1896, Gallman, Copiah County, Mississippi, buried: Alford Cemetery, Copiah County, MS. Her parents immigrated from Ireland when her father was about fifteen years old. Julius died Oct 15 1899, Gallman, Copiah County, Mississippi, buried: Alford Cemetery, Copiah County, MS. He was enumerated in Copiah Co. MS in 1850 age 40, 1860 age 53 and 1870 age 68.

16. **James Alford** b. 1764, Robeson Co., NC, m. about 1788, **17. Alice Katrain McTyer**, b. Abt _ 1769, Robeson Co., NC, d. about 1837, Copiah Co., MS, buried: Ard Cemetery, Copiah Co., MS. James died Feb 19 1839, Copiah Co., MS, buried: Ard Cemetery, Copiah Co., MS. AAFA ACTION, June 1991 page 58 has an account of his life with his will.

32. **Jacob Alford** b. Dec 12 1738, New Kent Co., VA, baptized: Feb 18 1738, New Kent Co., VA, m. **33. Mary Pace**, b. Feb 1740, d. after 1810, Robeson Co., NC, buried: Fulmore Cemetery, Robeson Co., NC. Jacob died about 1814, Robeson Co., NC. His will was dated July 4, 1794. Contents need to be included here. Some family tradition says he is buried in the Fulmore, sometimes called Ashpole, cemetery in Robeson Co. NC but there are no stones or other evidence of his burial there.

64. **Lodwick Alford** b. about 1710, New Kent Co., VA, m. (1) Elizabeth Cade, b. Apr 29 1717, New Kent Co., VA, d. May 29 1735, New Kent Co., VA, m. (2) **65. Susanna Cade**, b. Sep 25 1718, m. (3) Unknown. There are some who think Susanna was a Hartley but there is no evidence to support the idea. Others think she was a Cade with Lodwick turning to his late wife, Elizabeth Cade's, sister to help with the raising of young William Alford. See the comments about sister Elizabeth Cade the supposed previous wife of Lodwick. Lodwick died 1800, Franklin Co., NC. There has long been a family tradition- reinforced by some DAR records- that Lodwick married a Rebecca Ferrell. Nothing has been found to support this idea. A North Carolina court record lists his wife as Sarah and some believe he married, Sarah the widow of his brother Goodrich. It appears that the daughters of Goodrich were mentioned in Lodwick's will. There is nothing to indicate the mother of any of the children other than William, Elizabeth and Jacob whose births are recorded in St. Peter's Parish, New Kent County, VA.

128. **James Alford** b. about 1687, probably New Kent Co., VA, died about 1730, New Kent Co., VA. Birth and death dates are estimates based on other recorded events in New Kent County, VA in the St. Peter's Parish Register. PLEASE NOTE: It is not proven that he was the son of John Alford but there is some circumstantial evidence indicating that he is.

256. John Alford b. about 1645, probably Virginia, died Mar 14 1710, New Kent Co., VA.
